

『 **Bertrand Russell** 伯特兰·罗素（英国哲学家、数学家、诺贝尔文学奖得主） 』

- The Principles of Mathematics 数学原理
- A History of Western Philosophy 西方哲学史

**Bertrand Russell** (British philosopher, mathematician and Nobel laureate)

He developed new ideas connecting mathematics and logic. He was also known as a



pacifist, and he was one of the leading members of the opposition to nuclear weapons.

He received the Nobel Prize for literature in 1950.

※ Some old people **are** oppressed by the fear of death.

『 **be oppressed by the fear of...** 因为怕...而烦恼 』

- Many people are **oppressed by the fear of** **unemployment/ inflation**.
- Many girls are **oppressed by the fear of** **getting fat**. 因害怕发胖而烦恼

Many people are **oppressed by the fear of** **being unable to afford** the medical, educational and housing expenses. 因害怕负担不起...而烦恼

※ In the young there **is** a justification for this feeling.

『 **in sb.** 在某人身上 』

- You can feel helpfulness and care even **in these small children**. 在这些小孩身上
- **In this tall lean man**, you can see a leader of great modesty. 在这个又高又瘦的男人身上
- The desire for adventure is strong **in the young**. 在年轻人身上

**at a young age** 在年轻时

**At a young age**, Joni had a terrible diving accident. 在年轻的时候, 乔妮遭遇了一次严重的车祸。

『 **there is a justification for...** 做某事是正当合理的 』

- In this condition, **there is a justification for** intervention. 有理由进行干预

**there is no justification for...** 做某事是毫无合理的

**There is no justification for** suicide bombing. 自杀式爆炸毫无合理性

『 **there be + 无灵主语** 地道句式 』

- **There is always hope that** the two sides will reach a peaceful resolution. 总是会有双方达成和平解决方案的希望 (there is always hope that ... 总是会有...的希望)
- **There is no denying that** social media has dramatically changed how we communicate. 不可否认的是, 社交媒体极大地改变了我们交流的方式 (there is no denying that ... 不可否认的是...)
- **There is no question that** she is the most qualified candidate for the job. 毫无疑问, 她是这份工作最合格的人选 (there is no doubt/question that ... 毫无疑问的是...)

- Given the strong sales figures, **there is every likelihood that** the company will expand next year. 鉴于强劲的销售数字, 该公司明年很有可能会扩张(**there is every likelihood that ...** 很有可能的是...)
- Due to the extreme weather, **there is little likelihood that** the flight will depart on time. 由于极端天气, 航班不大可能会准时起飞(**there is little likelihood that ...** 不大可能的是...)
- There is no shortage of** brilliant young people seeking opportunities in the tech industry. 在科技行业中, 有的是寻求机会的杰出年轻人(**there is no shortage of ...** 有的是...; 不缺乏...)

**There is probably an element of truth in** this argument, but they ignore a more basic fact that the freedom of the press is often abused.

Albert Einstein once **attributed** the creativity *in a famous scientist* to the fact that he never went to school. **There is** undoubtedly **a truth in** his observation, but such a truth is not criticism of schools.

- His father told everybody that Eric had been killed **in action**. 在战斗中
- Franz poured scorn on the idea, pointing out that his brother had been killed **in action** during the war.
- Many soldiers were wounded **in battle**.

『 **bitter** adj.painful; sorrowful 痛苦的 』

- She **shed bitter tears** when she heard the news. 她流下了痛苦的眼泪
- It was a **bitter** experience that she would never forget.
- The failure left him with a **bitter** feeling.

『 **in the + 表示感觉的名词** belief / thought / discovery that... 因为某人相信/认为/发现... (作原因状语) 』

- ...tax-collectors can make mistakes or act over-zealously **in the belief that (= because they believe that)** they are serving the public. in the belief that ... = because sb. believe that ... 因为某人相信.....
- The men of our family waded down through our flooded meadows with boathooks, **in the hope of being (=because they hope to be)** able to grapple a corner of the raft and pull it out of the current towards our bank. in the hope of doing / that ... 有这样地希望... (引出同位语) = because sb. hope to do / that ... 因为某人希望.....
- In the lift her thoughts were on lunch and a good rest; but when she got out at her own floor, both were forgotten **in her sudden discovery that (=because she suddenly discovered that)** her front door was open. in the discovery that ... = because sb. discover that ... 因为某人发现了.....
- Police are carrying out a house-to-house search **in the hope of** finding the missing girl.
- They leave unwanted objects in drawers, cupboards and attics for years, **in the belief that (=because they believe that)** they may one day need just those very things.

『 **at the... of...** 一...就 (作时间状语短语) 』

- On the other hand, your stomach would turn **at the idea of** frying potatoes in animal fat -- the normally accepted practice in many northern countries.
- Most of my friends live in the city, yet they always go into raptures **at the mere mention of the country.** at the mere mention of... 一提到就...
- She wept **at the mention of** the accident. 一提到就...

『 **know** v. experience; see 经历 』

- China has **known many wars.** 中国经历过许多战争
- The city must have **known prosperity.** 这座城市一定经历过繁荣

<b>see</b> v. 经历	He has <b>seen</b> better days. 他经历过更好的日子
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『 **joys and sorrows** 悲欢离合; 起起伏伏 (ups and downs) 』

- They have been through many **joys and sorrows** together.

- Life is full of **ups and downs.** 起起伏伏
- Despite the **joys and sorrows**, they remained optimistic.

『 **whatever work (that / which) it was in him(=within his ability) to do** 他力所能及的任何工作 』

『 **somewhat** 某种程度上；稍微(to some extent / degree) 』

- The fear of death is **somewhat abject.** 对死亡的恐惧有点可鄙
- The results were **to some extent** disappointing.
- I found the movie **somewhat** confusing.

※ The best way to overcome it -- so at least it seems to me -- is to make your interests gradually wider and more impersonal, until bit by bit the walls of the ego recede, and your life becomes increasingly merged in the universal life.

- The most **visible** sign of the intensity of the crisis is unemployment. 危机加剧的最明显迹象是失业情况。

- The movie received excellent reviews, **since** it features two Oscar-winning actors and a renowned director. (这部电影获得了极好的评价, 因为它由两位奥斯卡获奖演员和一位著名导演主演。)
- **Since** we are all here and ready, let's start the meeting immediately. (既然我们都到齐了并准备好了, 我们这就开始会议吧。)

※ **And if, with the decay of vitality, weariness increases, the thought of rest will be not unwelcome.**

『 **decay** v./n. 腐烂; 衰退、衰败 』

- Old civilization may **fall into decay**. 衰败
- The power of the Roman Empire was **decaying** at the time of Nero.
- Each civilization is born, it culminates, and it **decays**.

『 **unwelcome** adj. unwanted; undesirable 不想要的 』

- The mayor delivered **the unwelcome news** that city employees may have to take unpaid time off. 市长宣布了人们不想听到的消息, 所有城市雇员可能不得不进行不带薪休工。
- GIANNI MION'S holiday started with **an unwelcome surprise**. 詹尼米翁在假期的一开始就遇到了一桩意外事件。
